Zone 2 Women

1. BC Golf new bylaws were passed on March 5, 2025, in a Special Meeting. (via Zoom) These bylaws are modern and more streamlined. With these bylaws, the Zones will be governed by a standalone Zone Operating Agreement.

The main roles and responsibilities of a zone are:

- a. promote the sport of golf within their Zone
- b conduct tournaments and championships for different age groups and genders (eg. juniors, amateur, seniors)
- c. shall ensure that only members who have active Golf Canada memberships are eligible to enter Zone events.
- d. agrees to undertake further activities as BC Golf may require from time to time.

Financial support will be changing from 30 cents per club member to dollar amounts for holding zone championships and sending teams to the BC championships.

Hosting the women's championships \$500

Hosting the junior girls' championships \$500

Sending an amateur, a senior, and a junior girls team to BC — each @ \$250 = \$750.

Grant from BC Golf will be \$1750.

In addition to this grant, we receive \$1 from each Thompson Okanagan Public Player from BC Golf. This amount will vary from year to year.

2. BC Golf AGM held on April 9, 2025 via Zoom. Good standing with the finances. Had a successful year.
